• How to Assemble & Disassemble Tube and Connector


Note: Do not hold tube and connectors where you insert each piece as finger may be pinched.

(2) Finish the assembly of both connectors with the tube in between. Then insert the connectors into two separate tubes to complete a panel. (Fig. 3-1)

Do not assemble the tubes and connectors one by one. (Fig. 3-2)

(3) Put release pliers into holes that have safety lock pins coming through and squeeze the pliers to release the tube from the


